Channel Islands National Park (CHIS) is hiring a permanent, full-time GS-11 Botanist to work in the Natural Resource Management Division. Channel Islands National Park supports a diverse terrestrial flora, including many rare, relict, and endemic species. The Botanist will implement and oversee a robust, long-term Inventory and Monitoring Program that has been on-going annually since 1984. With 14 federally listed plant species within the Park, the incumbent will also play an important role in rare plant recovery and habitat restoration programs.

Channel Islands National Park is one of the most unique parks in the National Park Service. Composed of 5 islands and range of vegetative community types, CHIS is home to many endemic plant and animal species. This position will require significant time in beautiful, remote field settings during the monitoring season (February-June). Channel Islands National Park is headquartered in Ventura, CA. Home to wide open beaches, plenty of open space, mild year-round weather, and vibrant communities, Ventura County is a wonderful place to live.
