Minimum qualifications include required knowledge and abilities attained through training and experience equivalent to possession of a Bachelor's Degree from an accredited college or university in Regional Planning, Biology, Environmental and Natural Resource Planning, Environmental Biology, Environmental Studies, Environmental Management and Protection, or a closely related Natural Science field AND 3 years of professional planning experience.

A Master's Degree in a closely related field may be substituted for one year of required experience.
